

LEAD Capstone Rubric

Questions to answer for approval of capstone project:

1. Does capstone involve an experiential activity that is of significant duration (one semester, one summer)?
2. Does the student have specific goals that s/he will strive to accomplish during the capstone experience?
3. Does the capstone draw on previous courses involving classroom-based learning that are complementary to the experiential activity/ies?
4. Has the student identified a coach that can serve as a mentor for the experiential activity?

Rubric for Capstone Submission:

Overall project: The student will write up a description of the proposed capstone project, including goals to accomplish. A coach will be identified and will have signed off on the project. The proposal will be submitted to the director of the leadership minor for approval. At the end of the experience, the student will produce an ePortfolio that will consist of critical guided reflection on the experience. The ePortfolio is to detail the discovery, comprehension, critical reflection and application of the leadership experience in conjunction with the integration of leadership coursework.

Goal: To provide a platform where minor candidates will share their leadership experiences in partnership with curricular learning, to showcase their comprehensive leadership learning, reflection, application and growth (knowing, doing, being) during their Cornell experience.
